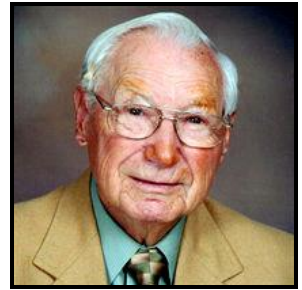


Obituary for Ross Curtsinger
