Good Afternoon:

First I want to thank all my Prayer Warriors and tell you that my biopsy on my lung/sternum area was negative for cancer. This was a node that showed up on the PET scan. So for now the cancer behind the ear is gone and the lungs were clear. There is still a small spot showing on the spine. I will have to wait and see what my oncologist wants to do. I return to Houston next week for eye surgery. Due to the growth on the salivary gland, my eye and smile has drooped. They will remove some of the excess eyelid skin, insert a sliver of gold into the lid so the eye will close, and take a tuck on the corner. This should help with my dry eye condition. I ask if I should add this to my will since the price of gold is up. I don't believe the family will have to fight over this windfall. Chemo is still not off the table, but every biopsy has given me hope. SO, I humbly thank you for your prayers! The Good Lord is definitely taking his lowly servant under his care.
