The Internet that the city of Pharr was discussed. Here are some bits of information you need to know.

The city is setting up an internet/wifi for its citizens. The cost is \$25 or \$50 (depending on the speed). (There are some governmental discounts offered, The city staff should know if you're eligible.

You must register with the city. Amigo section residents can do it online at teampharr.net. Tip Residents must call the city offices 956-402-4000. (You need to tell them that you pay the office for your water so you don't have an account with them).

There is no fee to sign up but this gets you in line to be installed once they get to our area. For the \$25 or \$50 you get a router, modem and installation (no charge).

Remember this is for Internet/Wifii only. No cable/TV stations come with. You will need to set that up separately.
