You must register with the city. Amigo section residents can do it online at <u>teampharr.net</u>. Tip Residents must call the city offices 956-402-24000. (You need to tell them that you are from the Tip)

There is no fee to sign up but this gets you in line to be installed once they get to our area. For the \$25 or \$50 you get a router, modem and installation (no charge).

Remember this is for Internet/Wifii only. No cable/TV stations come with. You will need to set that up separately.

During our conversation it was mentioned that a car entered the park through the exit gate. Two residents followed them and asked what they were doing. They didn't know where they were going and couldn't give a name. Our brave residents followed them until they left the park. They asked if that was what they should do. The neighborhood watch said to call the police right away if there is a suspicious car in the park (especially coming through the out gate). We don't recommend approaching for safety reasons. This is private property and the gates are there for a reason. If they knew where they were going or had a lot number or name that is a little different.
