Hi Everyone: Just wanted to let you know what's been going on with us. Jack has been sick for the last 2 months. He quit eating and lost from 168 down to 147 in just a matter of weeks. He was having trouble breathing even though he is on oxygen 24/7. I took him to his lung Dr. 2 weeks ago and they done a chest X-Ray. They found a mass in the upper part of his lung so they called us back in a few days later for a CT Scan. The Dr. suggested that we come back the very next day and they were gonna pull the liquid from around his lungs to maybe help him breath better. He was really gasping for air. He got to the point to where he could not even walk because of exerting himself. We went in the next morning and they pulled out 2 liters of liquid from around his lungs. They sent it off to be analyzed. We got a call 3 days later saying it was cancerous. He goes back in to the Dr. Tomorrow afternoon for a postate biopsy. We probably won't know anymore for a week or so. Jack can go from his chair to the bedroom, but I have to turn up his oxygen until he gets there. He does not leave the house except for Dr. appointments. He doesn't spend much time on the computer anymore. I will keep you all posted as I find out more. Pam
