## Robert Gow "Bob" Mustarde (1920 - 2010)



Robert "Bob" Gow Mustarde, 90, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, June 15, 2010. Funeral: 9:30 a.m. Friday in Greenwood Chapel. Interment: Greenwood Memorial Park. Visitation: open. Memorials: Expressions of sympathy donations can be made to Vitas Innovative Hospice Care, 2501 Parkview Drive, Suite 600, Fort Worth, Texas 76102, or to the Texas Pythian Home, Weatherford. Bob was born Jan. 7, 1920, in Glasgow, Scotland. He came to the United States through Ellis Island, N.Y., with his parents in 1923. His family settled in Utica, N.Y. Though he was very proud of his Scottish heritage, he loved his country very much and proudly served in World War II in the U.S. Army 11th [Armored](#) Division Combat Unit. Bob moved to Fort Worth in 1951. He was married for 54 years to Ruth Kline. Bob was a member of the Fort Worth Knights of Pythias Lodge, serving as grand chancellor of Texas from 1991 to 1992. He also served as president of Lake Worth Chamber of Commerce, Lake Worth Kiwanis Club and the 11th Armored Division [Association](#). Bob was preceded in death by his wife, Ruth, in 1997. Survivors: Wife, Mary; children, Barbara Bryce, Dan Mustarde, John Mustarde and wife, Linda, and Bonnie Newkirk and husband, Jimmy; five grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.
