How are we? I am fine. Jm had a massive heart attack with muscle damage on aug. 16. Just came home from painting at 3 and said he was just too tired to work anymore that day. a shower did not revive him and i nagged to go to hospital and he agreed about 4:00. they said if he had waited till after dinner, he probably wouldn't have made it. he did not have typical symptoms--just tired and an ache in middle of chest. he had been painting 10 foot ceilings and thought that was cause of pain. so he has been housebound for two weeks and can just walk a lot from one end of house to other. both boys came home for several days. tomorrow is first rehab. we'll know more then. but he feels just great and seems that was too.

still planning on texas. don't know if we are bringing motorhome or if we'll try to find something to rent. main problem is that i can't sleep lying down-darn fibromyalgia-so would need a recliner.

yvonne called here last night too. sorry for news but it is best for her.

better go. we think of you often. will try to send 2 emails one more time. love, peg

Yvonne Crockett called me last night. She has moved into an apartment close to her son. She will not be coming to TX.
