After a battle with lung and bladder problems, Harvey was going to be released to return to Colonial Manor yesterday. Instead heart problems developed and his stay at Renaissance prolonged.

Main problem now is he has a "trapped" lung and if he drinks from a glass or through a straw, the liquid will go into his lungs.

Carol has been shown how to feed him thickened applesauce (or other soft food) at about half a teaspoon at a time.

Wait until

he swallows, then another half teaspoonful. She said it took her half an hour to get 8 oz. into him this morning.

He responded well to medication for heart problem but doctor wants to keep him in the hospital a little longer.

Carol asked for your continuing prayers.
