


# Burn the Ships

Oh, It's time to--





Into tomorrow





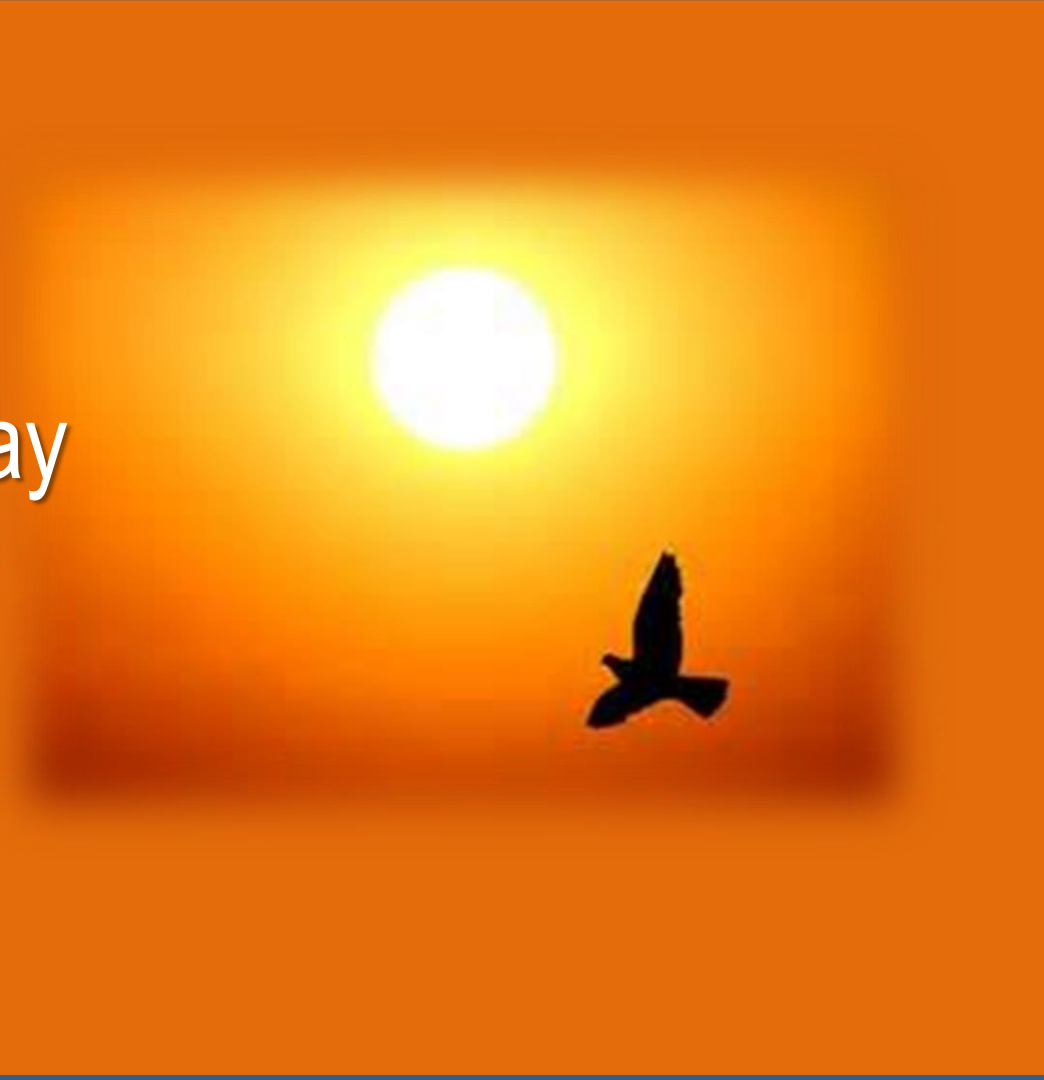
So flush the pills

again.




