Bob was born Jan. 7, 1920, in Glasgow, Scotland. He came to the United States through Ellis Island, N.Y., with his parents in 1923. His family settled in Utica, N.Y. Though he was very proud of his Scottish heritage, he loved his country very much and proudly served in World War II in the U.S. Army 11th Armored Division Combat Unit. Bob moved to Fort Worth in 1951. He was married for 54 years to Ruth Kline. Bob was a member of the Fort Worth Knights of Pythias Lodge, serving as grand chancellor of Texas from 1991 to 1992. He also served as president of Lake Worth Chamber of Commerce, Lake Worth Kiwanis Club and the 11th Armored Division Association.

Bob was preceded in death by his wife, Ruth, in 1997.
