Remembering Rene

Rene St. James passed away at home, with wife and partner, Donna on August 27th (just days short of their 58th anniversary). Rene was a founding member of the Overnite Chargers; WOTL's infamous e-biker gang. You might know Rene as the instigator of Card Elimination, Indoor Carpet Bowling, or as coordinator of Shuffleboard, Corn Roasts, or Wellington's many parades and dozens of WOTL events where he was present with camera in hand.

The e-bikers are funding a plaque to be mounted on the bench across from Rene and Donna's bench located in the parkette at Empire and Prince Edward Dr. In addition, we are initiating a fundraising event in support of the Picton hospital as tribute to the man who gave so much of his time and energies to supporting this community.

The Picton hospital's BacktheBuild Fundraiser has an account set up for WOTL residents to contribute to the new hospital build account in Rene's name.
