Motorcycle crash on I-74 kills Morton driver, 68

Galesburg – A Morton man was killed Friday afternoon on Interstate 74 after his three-wheeled motorcycle left the roadway and he was thrown from the vehicle.

Jim L. Parker, 68 of 608 Columbus Ave. was pronounced dead at the scene about 4:40 pm. Knox County Coroner Mark Thomas said.

Thomas said he wasn't sure if Friday's rainy conditions contributed to the crash and caused the vehicle to drive off the roadway near mile marker 54. Illinois State Police are investigating.

Parker was wearing a helmet at the time of the crash.
