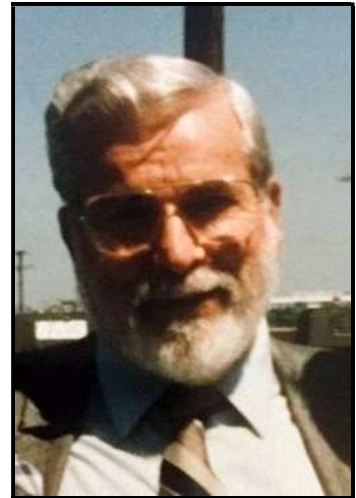


Charles Morris Perkins

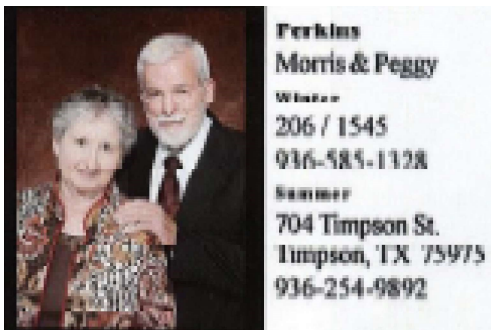
