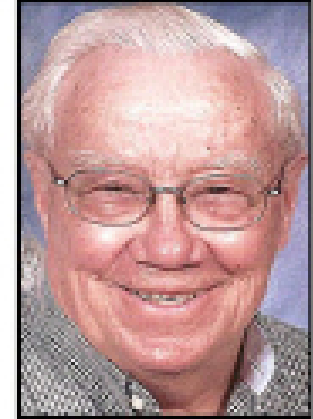


William A. (Bill) PETERS
