

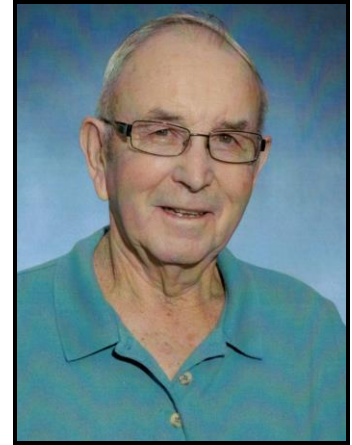
JC Russell

MARSHALL- JC Russell, 87, of Marshall, Indiana died Saturday, December 26, 2015 at Life Care Hospital North in McAllen, Texas.
