April 15, 1918 to May 2, 2014

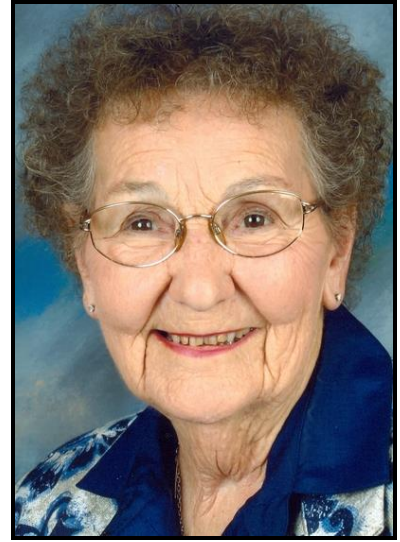
Opal Alverta Scott, 96, of Bradford died at 1:58 a.m. Friday, May 2, 2014, at Proctor Hospital in Peoria.
