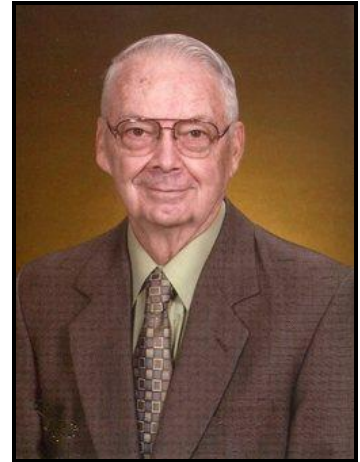


Carroll E. Titemore
