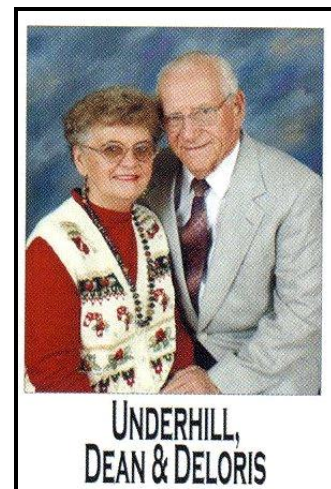


On May 27, 1978 Dean married Deloris Marie Brown in Ulysses, KS. She survives.
