

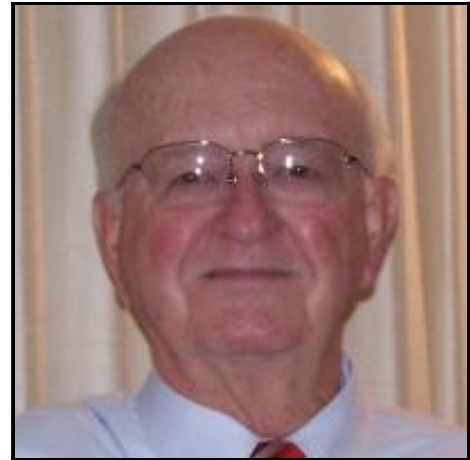
Horace Young
